

ECLIPSED EVOLUTION AUDIOBOOKS PUBLISHING IN SPRING 2024 FROM ACCLAIMED AUTHOR KIM HARRISON

The novella trilogy includes First Contact, Totality, and Emergence

NEW YORK, NY (October 23, 2023) – Penguin Random House Audio will publish audiobooks of *Eclipsed Evolution*, a trilogy of novellas from #1 *New York Times* bestselling author of the *Hollows* series Kim Harrison, in spring 2024.

The *Eclipsed Evolution* trilogy's three phases include *First Contact* (on sale April 2, 2024), *Totality* (on sale May 7, 2024) and *Emergence* (on sale June 4, 2024) and coincide with the total solar eclipse that will cross North America on April 8, 2024. Harrison's publisher Ace Books will release ebook editions later in 2024.

In the wake of the solar eclipse in *Eclipsed Evolution*, a portal between our world and a paranormal realm opens—and a scientist's life will never be the same. This thrilling serialized adventure introduces environmental balance engineer Dr. Renee Caisson and combines a touch of romance, a lot of action, and Kim Harrison's trademark sense of humor.

After Dr. Caisson is recruited to a secret government project, she is shocked to learn her subjects are demonic-looking beings who call themselves "Neighbors"—refugees from a dying world, who arrived during the nationwide solar eclipse. The Neighbors' technology is unlike anything Renee has ever encountered.

It's not until August, the most gregarious Neighbor, begins evolving in real time to withstand Earth's brighter, drier atmosphere does she admit that the Neighbors' "tech" feels less like science and more like magic—and she is able to prove her theory: the Neighbors had been to Earth before and now they simply wanted to save their dying planet. At least, that's the story, and everyone—both human and Neighbor—is sticking to it.

Together, Renee and August forge a bond and help the two societies of Nextdoor and Earth through the confusion of first contact, the danger of misunderstandings, and the anger of mistreatment. For if the people of Earth exile August's people again, the Neighbors will not survive.




