Cece Bell's EL DEAFO named a 2024 Odyssey Award audiobook; Pedro Martín's MEXIKID recognized as an Odyssey Honor

NEW YORK, NY (January 22, 2024) – The American Library Association's Odyssey Award committee named Cece Bell's **EL DEAFO** the 2024 Odyssey Award winner for children (Listening Library; available now) and Pedro Martín's **MEXIKID** an Odyssey Honor audiobook (Listening Library; available now). Both audiobooks are graphic novel adaptations performed by full casts were recognized during the ALA's Youth Media Awards livestream this morning.


Cece Bell's Newbery Honor-winning graphic novel **EL DEAFO** was adapted for audio with a full cast and sound effects, produced by Matie Argiropoulos and narrated by Sarah Tubert, Lexi Finigan, Jennifer Aquino, Fred Berman, Bailey Carr, Nicky Endres, Matt Godfrey, Avi Roque and Sanya Simmons. Starting at a new school is scary, especially with a giant hearing aid strapped to your chest! Then Cece makes a startling discovery. With the Phonic Ear she can hear her teacher not just in the classroom but anywhere her teacher is in the school—in the hallway... in the teacher's lounge... in the bathroom! This is power. Maybe even superpower! Cece is on her way to becoming El Deafo, Listener for All. Can Cece channel her powers into finding the thing she wants most, a true friend? The audiobook production adapts speech Cece hears when she is not wearing her hearing aids for listeners with a modulated effect. An animated screen adaptation of **EL DEAFO** is now streaming on Apple TV+.

Pedro Martín's **MEXIKID**, also a 2024 Newbery Honor winner, is poignant, hilarious, and unforgettable graphic memoir adapted for audio; produced by Diane McKiernan and Olivia Langen and narrated by Oscar Emmanuel Fabela, Omar Leyva, Cynthia Farrell, Kevin Orduño, Elena Rey, Avi Roque, Christophe Landa, Daisy Guevara, Alejandro Vargas-Lugo and Fernando Monroy. **MEXIKID** is about a Mexican-American boy's family and their adventure-filled road trip to bring their abuelito back from Mexico to live with them. Pedro Martín has grown up hearing stories about his abuelito—his legendary crime-fighting, grandfather who was once a part of the Mexican Revolution! But that doesn't mean Pedro is excited at the news that Abuelito is coming to live with their family. After all, Pedro has 8 brothers and sisters and the house is crowded enough! Still, Pedro piles into the Winnebago with his family for a road trip to Mexico to bring Abuelito home, and what follows is the trip of a lifetime, one filled with laughs and heartache. Along the way, Pedro finally connects with his abuelito and learns what it means to grow up and find his *grito*.

The award's name is taken from the Greek *Odyssey* epic, which was originally told and passed down in the oral tradition. 
